**The following safety requirements are extracted from the PUB vessel permit conditions<sup>1</sup> and the code of conduct<sup>2</sup> and are to be adhered to by all rowers/coaches when using Pandan Reservoir**

## General

1. Every person must wear a Personal Floatation Device (PFD) when carrying out water activities in the reservoir
2. All vessels operating in the reservoir must have valid vessel permits
3. All vessel IDs must be legible and visible
4. Water activities are allowed only from 7:00am to 7:00pm
5. Keep within the designated zone
6. Do not smoke or litter in the reservoir
7. No wading, swimming, or immersing oneself in the reservoir, including capsized drills
8. Cease activities upon adverse weather conditions
9. The pontoon gate must be closed after the activity is complete

## Safety Boat

1. The driver must have a valid MPA manning license to operate the vessel
2. The vessel must be equipped with adequate lifesaving and fire-fighting appliances onboard
3. Keep within the speed limit of 5 knots
4. No storage of petrol/diesel onboard when the vessel is not in use
