Description of Activity

Singapore rowing association conducts rowing programmes and events aimed at promoting rowing in the city, in alignment with Singapore Government Agencies' objectives to activate the water spaces. Safety Precautions

- All rowers and on-water personnel are required to adhere to the Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) as displayed on site
- If rowers are unexpectedly caught in a storm / lightning they must return to the SRA pontoon or the canoeing pontoon (at the far end of the marked course) and seek shelter
- On-land rowers to remain under shelter
- Rowing will be called off if the weather prohibits rowing. All personnel are to seek shelter from closest building from evacuated pontoon under bad weather

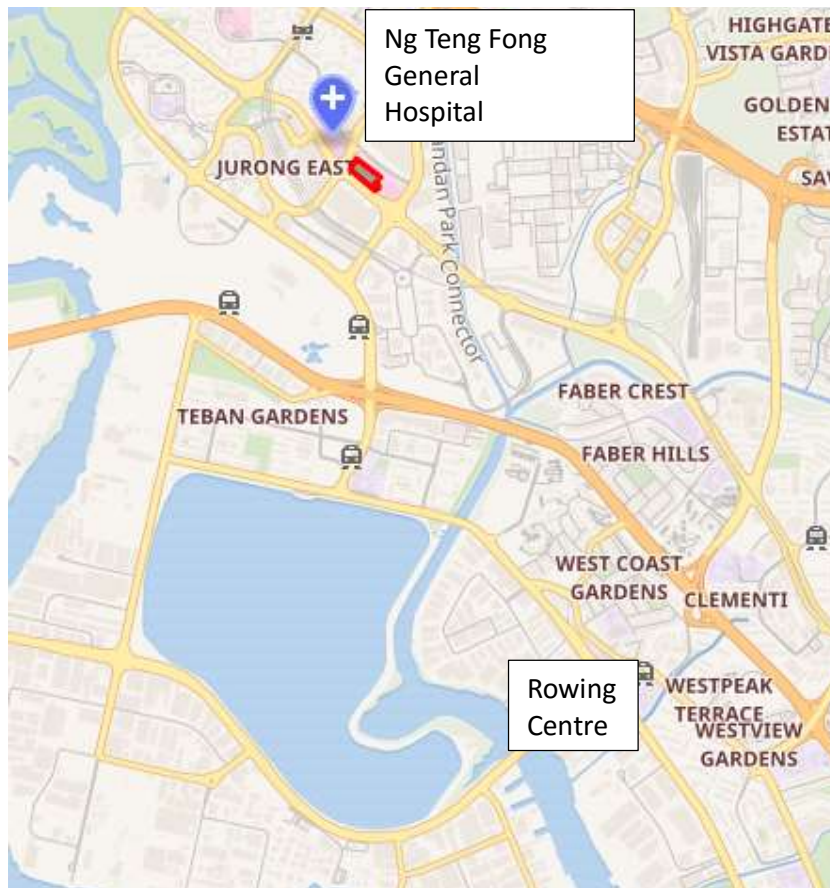
